AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT TO ACCEPT HIGHWAY SAFETY GRANT FUNDS FOR A MOTORCYCLE OPERATING WHILE INTOXICATED (OWI) ENFORCEMENT CAMPAIGN

The Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety, State of Wisconsin, is making funds available for participation in a 2015 High Visibility Motorcycle Operating While Intoxicated (OWI) Enforcement Project, Grant Number FG-2015-DANE CO-2695. The goal of this federally funded enforcement project is to decrease the number of motorcycle crashes from large motorcycle events where alcohol is sold. Grant activities are funded October 1, 2014 through September 30, 2015. The targeted enforcement is intended to increase the perception of law enforcement's presence; to deter drinking and operating of motorcycles, and to improve traffic safety and reduce crashes. Traffic laws will be enforced in and around the cities, towns and general locations where motorcycle specific events and activities occur.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to accept \$5,100 from the Department of Transportation, Bureau of Transportation Safety, for the high visibility motorcycle operating while intoxicated enforcement; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$5,100 is set up as additional revenue in the Sheriff's Office, Field Services, Motorcycle OWI Enforcement revenue account (SHRFFLD-82981) and to be credited to the General Fund; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$5,100 is transferred from the General Fund to the following accounts:
