











#### Goal 1: Protect existing habitat for wildlife and birds

- No row crops for >30 years with no tilling or chemical applications
- 19 acres of prairie restored already
- Supports >15 pairs of nesting Bobolinks





#### Goal 2: Restore areas to large tracts of unbroken grassland/native Wisconsin prairie

- Restore a portion of the former Koshkonong Prairie
- Elimination of wooded fence lines and mesic prairie restoration will result in a 1.15 mile stretch of unbroken prairie/grasslands
- Mesic prairie, the rarest habitat type in Wisconsin, will support diverse flora and fauna including several species of Greatest Conservation Need
