NACCHO Local Health Department (LHD) Accreditation Support Initiative (ASI)

PHMDC is moving towards accreditation and this grant will help support the process to become accredited.

This grant will be used to help implement an integrated performance management system to build capacity for outcomes-based work, accountability, and transparency within and outside of the department. This system will facilitate the development and use of meaningful data that can be analyzed and utilized for improved processes, programs, and outcomes across all levels of the health department. Specifically, NACCHO has awarded PHMDC \$14,280 to purchase this software to support performance management work and further support accreditation.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Health for Madison and Dane County, on behalf of Public Health—Madison and Dane County, is authorized to enter into an agreement with National Association of City and County Health Officials (NACCHO) accepting \$14,280 to fund the purchase of performance management software, and the director is authorized to sign the agreement.
