#### Intent/Justification

Dane County has crafted a partnership with the Laura and John Arnold Foundation to implement a validated, data driven risk assessment tool for use during the pretrial phase of criminal justice. In 2015, the CJC-Pretrial Services Subcommittee recommended that the county pursue race-neutral, validated risk assessment tools and subsequent research revealed the Public Safety Assessment (PSA) developed by the Laura and John Arnold Foundation as the most appropriate tool. Harvard University researchers will complete a multi-year study on the outcomes of use of the tool in Dane County. The PSA is designed to assist court personnel determine whether a defendant will be detained or released before trial.
