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INCREASING 2014 PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT WITH JOURNEY MENTAL HEALTH CENTER, INC. FOR KAJSIAB HOUSE SERVICES DCDHS - ACS DIVISION

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

Journey Mental Health Center, Inc. operates Kajsiab House, a day support program for members of the Hmong community who experience post traumatic stress disorder and other mental health diagnoses. Because there is no GPR support, the Department of Human Services has historically awarded Journey MHC 100% of the Medicaid revenue it earns each year. The current 2014 contract for Kajsiab House is \$510,056. Actual 2014 Medicaid revenue earned is \$589,573, or \$79,517 more than currently budgeted. The resolution increases the professional services contract with Journey Mental Health Center, Inc. by \$79,517 to reflect actual Medicaid revenue earned.

Current Policy or Practice -

Budget and professional service contract changes require County Board approval.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

The noted 2014 revenue and expenditure accounts will be modified and the following revenue increase be credited to the General Fund and transferred from the General Fund to the noted expenditure account in the Department of Human Services. The professional services contract with Journey Mental Health Center, Inc. will be ammended.
