Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

Construction services to convert the existing waste transfer facility into a material recovery (recycling) facility for construction and demolition (C&D) waste. The project will include a building addition of approximately 7,800 square feet and renovation of the existing transfer station building to accommodate sorting and processing equipment, the addition of rest rooms and a tour viewing area, and associated site, electric, and HVAC improvements.

Current Policy or Practice -

Public Works contracts of this amount require County Board approval.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Project will move forward. This will allow us to meet the needs of local municipalities and businesses for recycling construction and demolition material, without the current expense and environmental impact of transporting the material to Appleton for recycling.

Division will spend \$5,190,000 in borrowing for this project in 2015 (\$3,600,000 currently in the capital budget for this project and \$1,590,000 to be transferred from two other completed capital project accounts). Repayment of bonding will be from Solid Waste Division funds, from tipping fees collected for C&D recycling, which do not use GPR.
