AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION AND JURISDICTIONAL TRANSFER OF CTH Q WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF WAUNAKEE AND THE TOWN OF WESTPORT

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

Dane County Dept of Public Works, Highway & Transportation and representatives of the Village of Waunakee and the Town of Westport have determined that CTH Q will be reconstructed from Woodland Drive to STH 113. CTH Q from 370 feet north of Meffert Road to STH 113 shall be jurisdictionally transferred to the Village and Town within their respected limits on November 1, 2017, and will no longer be a County Trunk Highway.

Current Policy or Practice -

Dane County Highway and Transportation has an agreement for the reconstruction and jurisdictional transfer of this project with the municipalities.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

The County's maximum share is \$1,060,000. After the fund transfer of \$460,000 the County has funds available in account HWCONCAP-59069 for the project costs.
