All funding is contingent upon Federal action on these programs.

The CDBG Commission recommends that if there are not sufficient funds available for the programs recommended for CDBG or HOME funding, that:

- Decreases will be made to comply with the federal caps on administration, Community Housing Development Organization (CHDO), and public services funds;
- Public services funds will receive an equal percentage reduction across the board;
- Funds available for reallocation, such as dollars unexpended from prior year contracts, will be used to offset the cuts.

Contingencies:

- In the event of an increase of CDBG funds, Badger Prairie Needs Network and Project HOME will receive equal percentage amounts; no project will receive more than its requested amount.
- Public Service projects recommended for funding will receive an equal percentage increase in funding until the public services cap is met; no project will receive more than its requested amount.
- In the event of an increase of CDBG-CV funds, Badger Prairie Needs Network will receive the excess funds not exceeding the requested amount.

Dane County is an Entitlement community under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and Home Investment Partnerships (HOME) programs. The County receives approximately \$1.2 million in CDBG funding and \$600,000 in HOME funding. In order to allocate CDBG and HOME funds, HUD requires the development of a Consolidated Plan that governs how Dane County and the 56 participating municipalities expend the federal funds and the submittal of a One Year Action Plan.

CDBG funds are intended to develop viable urban communities by providing decent housing and a suitable living environment, and by expanding economic opportunities, principally for low-and-moderate income persons. HOME funds are to be used exclusively to create affordable housing for low-income households.
