Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

Dane County has been awarded a DNR Urban Forestry Grant of \$25,000. 2015 Res-235 authorized the grant application and acceptance of the grant award. The grant award will support the following: 1. Update to Dane County's Emerald Ash Borer (EAB) Plan, 2. Update to Dane County Parks tree inventory, 3. Tree removal and planting at Token Creek and Mendota County Parks, and 4. Public information and education on EAB.

Current Policy or Practice -

Grant acceptance requires County Board approval.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

\$25,000 to be set up as additional revenue in the LWRD Administration Division Urban Forestry Grant Revenue Line and be credited to the General Fund; and \$25,000 is transferred from the General Fund to the following expenditure accounts: 1. LWRD Administration Division Tree Inventory (LWRADMIN – NEW EXPENDITURE LINE) \$7,000, and 2. LWRD Administration Division LTE-Forestry (LWRADMIN – NEW EXPENDITURE LINE) \$18,000.
