## AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDING FOR LAW ENFORCEMENT CRISIS INTERVENTION TRAINING

The State of Wisconsin Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) and Crisis Intervention Partners (CIP) is providing grant funding for specialized crisis intervention training for law enforcement. Funding of \$1,205, administered by the Dane County, Wisconsin National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI), will provide for the Sheriff's Office to host a 40 hours crisis intervention training, held November 28, 2016 – December 2, 2016, to instruct law enforcement personnel how to better respond to people experiencing a mental health crisis. \$1,205 will provide for reimbursement of overtime for training efforts and for the printing of training material.

CIT/CIP training is a community initiative designed to improve the outcomes of law enforcement's interactions with people living with mental illnesses. CIT/CIP programs are local partnerships between law enforcement, mental health providers, Dane County NAMI, community stakeholders, families, and people living with mental illness. Crisis intervention training will include overview of various mental illnesses (symptoms, treatments, myths and facts), presentations & discussion with family members and people living with mental illness, and education on de-escalating mental health crises safely and effectively.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Dane County Sheriff is authorized to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding with NAMI Wisconsin to accept grant funding of \$1,205 to provide for overtime reimbursement for training efforts and for the printing of training material; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that \$1,205 is set up as additional revenue in the Sheriff's Office Security Division, Crisis Intervention Grant revenue account line (SHRFSEC NEW), and is credited to the General Fund; and

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that \$1,205 is transferred from the General Fund to Sheriff's Office Security Division following operating expense account lines:
