#### **Policy Analysis Statement:**

# Brief Description of Proposal -

For the second year in a row, the Wisconsin Department of Health Services has awarded Dane County Department of Human Services a Domestic Abuse in Later Life Grant. The amount of this year's grant is \$4,753. The funds will be used to partially underwrite the costs of a Domestic Abuse in Later Life conference to be held on November 13, 2015 at Alliant Energy Center. The conference is being planned by the Coordinated Community Response - Elder Abuse committee and DCDHS' Adult Protective Services Unit. It is hoped that this fall's conference will be well attended and enable community professionals to better understand this hidden, under-reported issue

## Current Policy or Practice -

Budget and professional service contract changes require County Board approval.

#### Impact of Adopting Proposal -

2015 revenue and expenditure accounts be modified. The 2014 funding was also used for a full day conference attended by more than 150 people and which was highly praised. If these funds are not accepted, DCDHS will not be able to educate community professionals regarding domestic abuse in later life and professionals will not increase their knowledge and skills regarding this under-reported issue.
