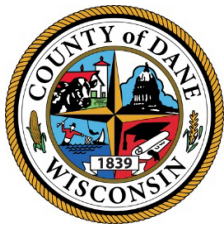
ADDENDUM #5 TO THE CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING
SERVICES RELATED TO THE DEPARTMENT OF WASTE AND RENEWABLES
PROJECTS

The Department of Waste and Renewables awarded Contract #14682 to Tetra Tech on April 14, 2022, in the amount of \$225,000 for providing professional engineering services for Landfill Site No. 2 and Site No. 1, RFP 321029.

Dane County Department of Waste and Renewables has determined that an Increase to PO #20260941 by \$109,000 will be necessary to complete a feasibility analysis on various treatment technologies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Executive and the County Clerk be authorized to sign the Addendum #5 to the Agreement; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Department of Waste and Renewables be directed to ensure complete performance of the Addendum #5 to the Agreement.

ADDENDUM # 14682E

Revised 11/2024

THIS ADDENDUM, made and entered into effective as of the date by which both parties hereto have executed this document, by and between the County of Dane (hereinafter referred to as "County") and Tetra Tech (hereinafter, "Provider").

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS Provider and County, by a separate document (hereinafter, the "Master Agreement"), Dane County Contract #14682, have previously entered into a contractual relationship pursuant to which Provider provides professional engineering services, and

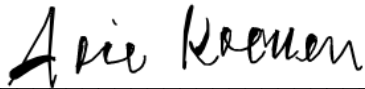
WHEREAS County and Provider wish to amend the Master Agreement in order to expand the scope of services.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the above premises and the mutual covenants of the parties hereinafter set forth, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged by each party for itself, the parties do agree as follows:

1. The Master Agreement shall remain in full force and effect unchanged in any manner by this addendum except as changes are expressly set forth herein. This addendum shall control only to the extent of any conflict between the terms of the Master Agreement and this addendum.
2. The Master Agreement, and any amendment or addendum to it, may be executed and transmitted to any other party by legible facsimile reproduction or by scanned legible electronic PDF copy, and utilized in all respects as, an original, wet-inked manually executed document. Further, the Master Agreement and any amendment or addendum thereto, may be stored and reproduced by each party electronically, photographically, by photocopy or other similar process, and each party may at its option destroy any original document so reproduced. All parties hereto stipulate that any such legible reproduction shall be admissible in evidence as the original itself in any judicial, arbitration or administrative proceeding whether or not the original is in existence and whether or not such reproduction was made by each party in the regular course of business. This term does not apply to the service of notices under the Master Agreement, or any subsequent amendment or addendum.
3. The term of the contract is extended through March 30, 2027 to complete a feasibility analysis on various treatment technologies, at an additional cost of \$109,000.00.
