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The Dane County Department of Waste and Renewables operates an active landfill at 7102 Maahic Way, Madison, WI 53718 and has an obligation to maintain surrounding areas free of windblown litter and debris as safely and cost effectively as possible.

The Department of Waste and Renewables reports receipt of bids (RFB No. 2025-RFB-025-PR) for windblown litter pickup services. A complete tabulation of the responses is on file at the Department of Waste and Renewables and the Dane County Purchasing Division. An agreement has been negotiated with the lowest qualified bidder:

The Department of Waste and Renewables staff finds the amount to be reasonable and recommends that the Agreement be awarded to A&L Cleaning Services, effective on the contract execution date and with expiration on or before December 31, 2029. There are sufficient funds available to complete this agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that an Agreement be awarded to A&L Cleaning Services in the amount of up to \$330,000 for litter pickup services; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Executive and County Clerk are authorized and directed to sign the Agreement; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Department of Waste and Renewables be directed to ensure complete performance of the Agreement.
