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elected officials before the earliest time for filing nomination papers for elective office. County Board rules also require the Personnel and Finance Committee to make recommendations on compensation levels by March 15 of even numbered years. Consideration of a resolution setting salary adjustments is one approach to making that recommendation. Nomination papers for the offices of Clerk of Courts and Sheriff will be filed in 2018. Compensation for these offices must be set prospectively and cannot be changed during the term of office.

The current salary for the Clerk of Courts is \$105,756, and the current salary

for the Sheriff is \$146,275. This resolution increases these salaries by 1.5% for 2019, 1.5% for 2020, 2.0% for 2021 and 2.0% for 2022

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the salaries for the offices of County Clerk, County Treasurer, and Register of Deeds be established as follows:
