2 SALARY ADJUSTMENTS FOR SHERIFF AND
3 CLERK OF COURTS
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7 State Statute requires the County Board to establish annual compensation for
8 elected officials before the earliest time for filing nomination papers for elective
9 office. County Board rules also require the Personnel and Finance Committee to make
10 recommendations on compensation levels by March 15 of even numbered
11 years. Consideration of a resolution setting salary adjustments is one approach to
12 making that recommendation. Nomination papers for the offices of Clerk of Courts and
13 Sheriff will be filed in 2018. Compensation for these offices must be set prospectively
14 and cannot be changed during the term of office.
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16 The current salary for the Clerk of Courts is \$105,756, and the current salary
17 for the Sheriff is \$146,275. This resolution increases these salaries by 1.5% for 2019,
18 1.5% for 2020, 2.0% for 2021 and 2.0% for 2022
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20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the salaries for the offices of
21 County Clerk, County Treasurer, and Register of Deeds be established as follows:
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Position	2019 Salary	2020 Salary	2021 Salary	2022 Salary
Clerk of Courts	\$107,342	\$108,952	\$111,132	\$113,354
Sheriff	\$148,469	\$150,696	\$153,710	\$156,784

23 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the 2019 salary shall become effective on
24 the date the officials are sworn in to office.
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
