D. Site Inspections for the July 25, 2019 Public Hearing

Board members visited the sites and inspected the property. No testimony or action were taken. The purpose of this inspection was for future action at the July 25, 2019 public hearing.

1. Appeal 3700 by Bryan and Mary McMillan (Cory Horton, RA Smith, Agent) for variance from minimum required setback to a wetland as provided by Section 11.03(2)(a)2., Dane County Code of Ordinances, to permit the construction of a single family residence at a property on Exchange Street being a lot in the NW ¼ of the NW ¼, Section 10, Town of Dunn.

2. Appeal 3701 by Peter Weeks for variance from minimum average lot width and minimum lot area in the shoreland zoning district as provided by Section 11.03(1)b, Dane County Code of Ordinances, and Section 5.2, Wisconsin Model Shoreland Zoning Ordinance, to permit consolidation of land to construct a single family residence on County Highway AB described as Lot 13 Colladay Park, Section 2, Town of Dunn.
