AUTHORIZATION TO ESTABLISH DANE COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS COORDINATOR (EPC) DONATION REVENUE AND EXPENDITURE ACCOUNTS

The effects of active shooter incidents have become more frequent, far-reaching, and widespread with the severity of incidents increasing, posing systemic threats to communities and their citizens. As a result, the Sheriff's Office, Emergency Preparedness Coordinator provides training to Dane County businesses, organizations, and community members, on what to do in an active shooter or emergency situation. Education is provided to Dane County citizens on how to survive violent encounters with the goal of taking action before an act of violence occurs and how to prepare for, and respond to, critical incidents and emergencies.

The Sheriff's Office requests the creation of donation, revenue and expenditure budget accounts, for the Emergency Preparedness Coordinator, to establish the capacity for the Sheriff's Office to accept donations from supporters. Donations will be used to assist with the cost of emergency preparedness training.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to accept financial support from fundraising, donations, and gifts from donors to support operating costs of emergency preparedness training for current and future expenses; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a revenue account line is established in Sheriff, Field Services Division, Friends of EPC (SHRFFLD-NEW) to be credited to the General Fund; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that an expenditure account is created in Sheriff, Field Services Division, Friends of EPC (SHRFFLD-NEW) whereby expenditures are authorized to the extent revenues are received and any unexpended funds are carried forward to the next fiscal year.
