WASTE AND RENEWABLES CONTRACT FOR SPECIALIZED DRILLING SERVICES WITH  
TRAUT COMPANIES TO ABANDON THREE PRIVATE WELLS AT THE DANE COUNTY  
LANDFILL SITE NO. 3

The Dane County Department of Waste & Renewables (W&R) owns and operates an active landfill (Landfill Site No. 2) located at 7102 Maahic Way, Madison, Wisconsin 53718. Permitting and design for Dane County Landfill Site No. 3 is currently underway.

W&R requested a waiver of bid and received approval from the Dane County Personnel and Finance Committee on November 24<sup>th</sup>, 2025 to utilize Traut Companies to abandon three private groundwater wells within the footprint of the proposed Dane County Landfill Site No. 3. The three wells are PW-C, PW-D and PW-E with depths varying between 360' and 890' below surface and outer casing diameters varying between 10" to 18". The abandonment of the wells requires specialized equipment and expertise and Traut was the only viable respondent to W&R's requests for qualifications.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that Traut Companies and W&R wish to enter into a Contract for specialized drilling services to abandon three private wells at Dane County Landfill Site No. 3, with a total contract amount of \$359,965.00; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County Executive and the County Clerk be authorized to sign the Agreement; and

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Department of Waste & Renewables be directed to ensure complete performance of the Agreement.
