**Intent/Justification**

Dane County occupies the ancestral, traditional, and contemporary lands of the Očhéthi Šakówiŋ, Ho-Chunk, Myaamia, Sauk and Meskwaki, Peoria, and Kiikaapoi nations. This amendment puts \$10,000 in the Cultural Affairs department budget to work with an artist/artists to install a mural or sculpture that acknowledges the land that Dane County occupies. The Office of Cultural Affairs will need to work with various city and county bodies in the siting of the artwork, including the City County Liaison Committee and the City Plan Commission.
