AMENDING CHAPTER 25 OF THE DANE COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES, REGARDING PAYMENT OF LIVING WAGE FOR INMATE WORKERS

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

This ordinance amendment proposes to pay Dane County Jail inmate workers, that work within the Dane County Jail system, a living wage. Living wage, as defined by County ordinance, is an hourly wage equal to 100% of the poverty level, divided by 2080. County ordinance mandates that employers pay their affected employees the hourly living wage for 2015 of \$11.47 for every hour worked on a County contract, subject to the rules set forth in the ordinance.

Current Policy or Practice -

Currently, Dane County Jail inmate workers receive a stipend and sentence credit for working .

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

A job provides inmates with a place to be for hours each day, providing a break from the monotony of jail life. Inmate work reduces inmate idleness and thus the potential for security problems. Inmate work provides opportunities for inmates to improve or develop job skills, work habits, and experiences that can assist in post-release employment. Paying a living wage to Dane County Jail inmate workers without reducing the number of inmate hours currently worked, significantly increases cost to the Dane County Jail.
