ADDENDUM #2 TO THE ENVIRONMENTAL MONITORING CONTRACT WITH SCS ENGINEERS FOR ADDITIONAL SERVICES AND COST INCREASES DUE TO INFLATION

Brief Description of Proposal -

Dane County Department of Waste & Renewables has determined it necessary for SCS to discontinue unnecessary services, perform additional services as required by newly issued operating permits for Site #3, and SCS has requested an increase in rates due to inflation as allowable by the terms of the contract. The increase to the contract is \$166,086.00 over the remaining two years of the contract (1/1/26-12/31/27).
