

1 **2022 RES-204 AS AMENDED**

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3 **AUTHORIZING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING REGARDING USE OF AMERICAN**
4 **RESCUE PLAN ACT OF 2021 (ARPA) FUNDING FOR THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE**
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6 The United States Department of the Treasury has distributed to the Wisconsin
7 Department of Administration, ARPA funding for the Law Enforcement Agencies (LEA) Safer
8 Communities Grant Program. On March 15, 2022, Wisconsin Governor Tony Evers announced
9 an investment of more than \$50 million to make Wisconsin communities safer which includes
10 \$19 million allocated for local and tribal law enforcement agencies in the state. The Sheriff's
11 Office shall receive an award of \$335,683 as part of this grant program for reimbursable
12 expenses incurred from March 15, 2022 through June 30, 2023 for costs associated with
13 Deputy hiring, training, testing, equipment needs, to update technologies and policies, and for
14 implementing crime reduction initiatives.

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to
17 accept \$335,683 from the Wisconsin Department of Administration, LEA Safer Communities
18 Grant Program, to support costs associated with the Sheriff's Office Deputy hiring, training,
19 testing, equipment, and to update technologies and policies, and for implementing crime
20 reduction initiatives: and
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22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that on behalf of the County of Dane, the County
23 Executive is authorized to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the Wisconsin
24 Department of Administration regarding use of ARPA funds; and
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26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that \$335,683 is appropriated as additional revenue in
27 the 2022 budget in account line Sheriff's Office, Administrative Services Division, LEA Safer
28 Communities Grant Revenue (SHRFADM NEW) and is credited to the General Fund; and
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30 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that \$335,683 is transferred from the General Fund in
31 the 2022 budget to account line Sheriff's Office, Administrative Services Division, LEA Safer
32 Communities Grant Expenditures (SHRFADM NEW); and
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34 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** prior to the expenditure of funds the Sheriff must obtain
35 **County Board approval**
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37 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that all unexpended funds and unrecognized revenues
38 from this grant are carried forward until fully expended.
