4 **AUTHORIZING WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE GRANT FUNDING FOR THE**  
5 **NEEDLE POINT BIPOLAR IONIZATION PROJECT**

6 The Wisconsin Department of Justice, Division of Law Enforcement Services has  
7 awarded a grant to Dane County for \$6,975. This award is through the Coronavirus Emergency  
8 Supplemental Funding Grant Program available through the U.S. Department of Justice to  
9 support Dane County's Needle Point Bipolar Ionization Project; Grant Number 2020-CV-01-  
10 16613, grant project period is June 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021.

12 Installation of Needle Point Bipolar Ionization in the HVAC system of the Dane County  
13 Law Enforcement Training Center will reduce pathogens, including COVID-19, save energy,  
14 neutralize odors, and reduce airborne particles.

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Sheriff's Office is hereby authorized to  
17 accept \$6,975 from the Wisconsin Department of Justice, Division of Law Enforcement  
18 Services; and

20 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** the County Executive is authorized to execute the grant  
21 agreement; and

23 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that \$6,975 is appropriated as additional revenue in the  
24 Sheriff's Office, Firearms Training Center, Ionization Project Revenue account line (SHRFTC  
25 NEW) and to be credited to the General Fund; and

27 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that \$6,975 is transferred from the General Fund to  
28 Sheriff's Office, Firearms Training Center, Ionization Project Equipment account line (SHRFTC  
29 NEW).
