ACCEPTANCE OF A WI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES
GRANT FOR THE RESURFACING OF THE CAPITAL CITY STATE TRAIL

The Land & Water Resources Department – Parks Division has secured a \$244,465 grant from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) for the resurfacing of the Capital City State Trail.

Nine miles of the Capital City State Trail is managed by Dane County Parks per a cooperative agreement with WDNR. The County plans a phased project to resurface those nine miles of trail. This project includes the first phase of trail resurfacing.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby accept the \$244,465 grant from the WI DNR,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that a new revenue account LEWSLUNY Capital Trail Rehab Grant shall be established for \$244,465 and expenditure account LEWSLUNY 58823 Capital Trail Rehab be increased \$244,465. All Funds shall be carried forward until realized and expended.
