Creating Section 23.47 of the Madison General Ordinances to provide authority to Madison Dane County Public Health to order the spaying or neutering of dogs that repeatedly run at large, act aggressively or cause injury to a person or property or in violation of Chapter 28.

Body

DRAFTER'S ANALYSIS: This ordinance permits Madison Dane County Public Health to order the spaying or neutering within thirty days of any dog that runs at large on three occasions, acts aggressively while running at large, or injuries another animal or person or is kept by an individual who has violated the zoning chapter relating to home dog breeding or sales. This ordinance also establishes a bail deposit for an owner that fails to comply with the Health Department's order.
