SALARY ADJUSTMENTS FOR COUNTY CLERK, REGISTER OF DEEDS AND TREASURER

State Statute requires the County Board to establish annual compensation for elected officials before the earliest time for filing nomination papers for elective office. County Board rules also require the Personnel and Finance Committee to make recommendations on compensation levels by March 15 of even numbered years. Consideration of a resolution setting salary adjustments is one approach to making that recommendation. Nomination papers for the offices of County Clerk, Register of Deeds, and County Treasurer will be filed in 2016. Compensation for these offices must be set prospectively and cannot be changed during the term of office.

The salaries for the County Clerk, Register of Deeds, and County Treasurer are set at \$94,611 for 2016. The resolution increases this salary by 2.7% for 2017, 2% for 2018, 1.5% for 2019 and 1.5% for 2020

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the salaries for the offices of County Clerk, County Treasurer, and Register of Deeds be established as follows:
