2014 RES-597 AUTHORIZATION TO APPLY FOR WISCONSIN DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES GRANTS – SNOWMOBILE TRAIL AIDS PROGRAM The Dane County Board by Resolution 113, 1975-1976 directed its Park Commission to develop, construct and maintain a public snowmobile trail program for recreational purposes under the State of Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR) Outdoor Recreation Aids Program. WHEREAS, the Dane County Parks Division and the Parks Director, with the assistance of the Dane County Council of Snowmobile Clubs, have developed and since maintained a quality snowmobile trail program for the enjoyment of the public, consistent with established WDNR guidelines. WHEREAS. Dane County Parks would like to continue to apply annually for Snowmobile Trail Program funding through the WDNR for trail maintenance, bridge and trail rehabilitation and other program needs. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Land & Water Resources Department has budgeted a sum sufficient to fully and satisfactorily complete the project and hereby authorizes and empowers the Dane County Parks Director or the Dane County Executive to submit the following documents to the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources for financial assistance that may be available. These include: Sign and submit a grant application, enter into a grant agreement with the WDNR, take necessary action to undertake, direct, and complete the approved project and bind the applicant, submit reports to the WDNR to satisfy the grant agreement, as appropriate, submit reimbursement request(s) to the WDNR no later than the date specified in the grant agreement and sign and submit all grant related materials. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Dane County will comply with state and federal rules for the program.
