The basins capture trash and phosphorus-laden debris such as yard or pet waste from urban areas that otherwise wash directly into lakes and streams when it rains. Since 2005, these grants have helped fund projects totaling nearly \$10 million dollars and are estimated to have removed more than 500,000 pounds of debris, and more than 2,000 pounds of phosphorus annually.
