

ACCEPTANCE OF A 2020 URBAN FORESTRY GRANT
FROM THE WI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES

The Land & Water Resources Department has secured an \$25,000 Urban Forestry grant from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WDNR).

The purpose of the grant is to develop an education and outreach program targeted at under represented groups in the tree care industry. The department will hire at least two (2) Limited Term Employees that come from existing Operation Fresh Start crews or other under represented groups to develop job skills important to success in the Urban Forestry Industry. The required match for this project is met by in-kind county expenditures for fuel, equipment and additional staff hours.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby accept the \$25,000 Urban Forestry grant from the WDNR,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Land & Waters Resources Director and the Forester Specialist are authorized to execute documents necessary to accept the funds,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that LWRADMIN account 80125 Urban Forestry Grant Revenue shall be increased by \$25,000. Account LWRADMIN 10097 LTE Forestry shall be increased by \$23,223 and LWRADMIN 10108 Social Security shall be increased by \$1,777. All Funds shall be carried forward until realized and expended.
