Andrew Eveland, Assistant Village Administrator of Belleville, presented the Carolina Street Park project. The Village plans to acquire two residential lots to develop a neighborhood park and trailhead, providing public access to 135 acres of natural conservancy land along the Sugar River. The project aims to connect Belleville through a network of trails and natural corridors, promoting environmental education, recreation, and community engagement. The Village is requesting a Dane County Conservation Fund Grant to cover 25% of the acquisition costs, approximately \$55,000.
