I FEEL THAT THE STORAGE OF RECREATIONAL UBHICUSS INSIDE EXISTING FARM BUILDINGS WILL HAVE LIBES EXPECT ON PABLIC HEALTH, SAKETY, COMFORT ER GENERAL WELFARE THAN THE DAIRY FARM DID WHEN IT WAS IN OPERATED.
- 2. The uses, values and enjoyment of other property in the neighborhood for purposes already permitted shall be in no foreseeable manner substantially impaired or diminished by establishment, maintenance or operation of the conditional use.

 THE USE, VALUE & ENJOYMENT OF OTHER PROPERTY IN THE AREA
