**AUTHORIZING ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE FY 2016 EDWARD BYRNE  
MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT (JAG) PROGRAM**

The City of Madison and Dane County are participating in the FY 2016 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program, Grant Number 2014-H2564-WI-DJ. Funding for the JAG Program is available October 1, 2015 through September 30, 2019. The grant awards \$96,148 to the City of Madison, Dane County will receive \$23,580 from the allocation of \$96,148 to be used as follows:

- \$6,330 to the Dane County Sheriff's Office for gas masks/filters, helmet lights, and an infrared illuminator scope
- \$11,500 for the Dane County Drug Court Treatment Program
- \$5,750 for the Dane County District Attorney Crime Response Program

Funding of \$11,500 for the Drug Court Treatment Program and \$5,750 for the District Attorney's Crime Response Program are reflected in the 2016 Adopted Budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Sheriff's Office is permitted to accept the FY 2016 Justice Assistance Grant funding, administered by the City of Madison, in the amount of \$6,330; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that \$6,330 is established, as revenue in the 2016 Budget, in Sheriff's Office Support Services Division, Justice Assistance Grant Revenue Account Line (SHRFSUP 83139) and is credited to the General Fund; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that \$6,330 is transferred, in the 2016 Budget, from the General Fund to the Sheriff's Office Support Services Division, Justice Assistance Grant Expenditure Account Line (SHRFSUP 47680).

**BE IT FINALLY FURTHER RESOLVED** that the County of Dane has executed a Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Madison and Dane County embodying the above referenced provisions.
