Dane County Zoning and Land Regulation Committee Members:

I would like to express my support for renewing the conditional use permit for Forever Sandfill and Limestone, Inc.

As a resident of Southeastern Dane County I believe not renewing the CUP will lead to increased road building cost for our area and ultimately cause higher taxes. The further that raw materials need to be hauled for building roads the more our cost will increase. In my opinion we already have too few gravel quarries in our area.

I have also known Forever Sandfill and Limestone, Inc. for more than 20 years, and I know them to be a responsible business partner in our communities and willing to work with local government to accommodate reasonable rules governing their CUP.

I work for Kriete Truck Center in Madison, WI, and we work with many of the operators that haul from the Deerfield Oak Park Quarry. Many of them are concerned about the Oak Park Quarry closing. They have stated the reason for their concern is that they would be hauling further and it would drive up their equipment maintenance and labor cost. They would necessarily need to pass along the increased cost on any bids they submit for road and project work. There is already a shortage of dump trucks and drivers to move the material.
