The YWCA, which has provided library training in the past, did not submit a proposal. Cream City Conservation has experience working with various companies and organizations on equity and inclusion training. Ms. Ball has presented to the Beyond the Page Oversight Committee and Dane County Library Directors about implementing equity teams and comprehensive training. There is a trust relationship that has been established between Cream City Conservation and the libraries.
