AUTHORIZING DONATION OF FUNDS FOR ANDERSON FARM COUNTY PARK

Anderson Farm County Park, located in south central Dane county, is one of Dane County's newest recreational parks. The Park is currently 300 acres in size and the master plan calls for a mix of recreational, agricultural and natural resource based activities.

The Anderson family has established two funds with the Natural Resources Foundation of Wisconsin to support development and maintenance of the Park.

The first fund is known as the Patty Anderson Working Fund and contains just over \$100,000. The Patty Anderson Working Fund was used to fund the master plan and initial park development and will continue to be used to support the Park until it has been spent.

The second fund is known as Patricia & Lyman Anderson Family Farm Endowment. An estimated \$7,500 may be received annually from the endowment to support the Park.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby accept \$100,525 from the Patty Anderson Working Fund with the Natural Resources Foundation of Wisconsin.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a revenue account LWRPKOP New "Anderson Farm Development" be established with a budgeted amount of \$100,525 and an expense account LWRPKOP New "Anderson Farm Development" be established with a budgeted amount of \$100,525 and that all funds shall carry forward until expended.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that expense account LWRPKOP New "Anderson Farm Maintenance" shall be established and revenue account LWRPKOP New "Anderson Farm Maintenance" be established for \$7,500. All funds shall carry forward from the revenue account to the expense account the following budget year and those funds shall carry forward until expended.
