

**Dane County Board of Supervisors  
Amending Chapter 10 of the Dane County Code of Ordinances  
Zoning Map Amendment Petition 11303**

Dane County Board of Supervisors does ordain as follows:

The Zoning Districts Maps as referenced under Dane County Code of Ordinance Section 10.03 shall be amended as follows:

**Town Map:** Town of Montrose

**Location:** Section 6

**Zoning District Boundary Changes**

**A-1EX to A-2(2)**

Part of the SE ¼ of the NE ¼ of Sec 6, T5N, R8E, Town of Montrose, Dane County, Wisconsin. Commencing at the East ¼ corner of Sec 6; thence S89°25'02"W, 428.46 feet along the South line of the NE ¼ of Sec 6 to the point of beginning; thence continuing S89°25'02"W, 66.02 feet and along the South line of the NE ¼ of Sec6; thence N02°01'36"W, 52.81 feet; thence N50°05'20"E, 234.89 feet; thence N32°25'48"W, 346.75 feet; thence N57°34'12"E, 225.63 feet; thence S14°16'33"E, 141.71 feet; thence S44°58'38"E, 150.53 feet; thence S23°21'00"W, 228.28 feet; thence S50°05'20"W, 219.60 to the North right-of-way line of Schaller Rd; thence S02°01'36"E, 22.20 feet to the point of beginning.

Containing ± 88,530 square feet (± 2.03 acres), ±87,120 square feet (± 2 acres), excluding road right-of-way.

**CONDITIONAL ZONING**

Conditional zoning is hereby imposed pursuant to Section 10.255(3)(a)2.(b) of the Dane County Code of Ordinances. The rezoned area shall be subject to the following conditions.

**CERTIFIED SURVEY REQUIRED**

The above listed description/s is/are intended to describe land for which a certified survey map will be prepared for approval and recorded. Within 90 days of rezoning approval by Dane County, a *final* certified survey map that describes the land to be rezoned shall be prepared in accordance with all applicable provisions of Chapter 236 Wisconsin Statutes and Chapter 75 Dane County Code of Ordinances, and submitted to the Dane County Zoning Division. Upon submission of the final certified survey map, the Zoning and Land Regulation Committee, or its authorized representative, shall, within 90 days, approve, approve conditionally, or reject the certified survey map. **Failure to submit the final certified survey within the 90 day period and/or failure to record the survey with the Dane County Register of Deeds will cause the rezone to be null and void. Two copies of the recorded survey shall be submitted to Dane County Zoning.**
