AMENDING CHAPTER 18 OF THE DANE COUNTY CODE OF
ORDINANCES, REGARDING PAID MILITARY LEAVE

The County Board of Supervisors of the County of Dane does ordain as follows:

ARTICLE 1. Unless otherwise expressly stated herein, all references to section and chapter numbers are to those of the Dane County Code of Ordinances.

ARTICLE 2. Section 18.29(5)(d) is amended to read as follows:

(d) ~~Effective January 1, 2003, t~~The County shall annually provide up to 30 days paid military leave to all employees. Paid military leave may be requested for any periods of active-duty (including training) duty in the Armed Forces of the United States under Title 10 or Title 32, United States Code, including active duty, active duty for training or inactive duty training, or for state active duty performed at the request of the Governor. The employee must provide proof of performance of said duty, such as a leave and earnings statement, ~~and said duty must be a minimum of three consecutive days in length.~~

[EXPLANATION: This amendment revises when an employee may use paid military leave.]
