Brief Description of Proposal -

American Transmission Company (ATC) has an existing transmission line running through the Lewis Nine Springs E-way and Capital Springs Recreation Area. The voltage of this line has increased through the years to 69kV and the code width for this voltage is 30 feet on each side. ATC is requesting two new easements in order to obtain the additional width needed for code compliance.

Current Policy or Practice -

Easements require County Board approval.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Based on an appraisal and negotiations with ATC, Dane County Land & Water Resources recommends accepting \$22,000 in compensation for the additional 6.7 acres of easement area.
