**ACCEPTING COVID RELIEF FUNDS AND AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURES FOR  
PERSONAL PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT AND DEVELOPMENT OF NURSING HOME  
COVID CARE AREA  
DCDHS – BPHCC DIVISION**

A direct distribution of Federal CARES Act funding has been transferred from the US Department of Health and Human Services to the Badger Prairie Healthcare Center (BPHCC) to be used for COVID-19 prevention and treatment costs. This resolution increases Dane County budget authority for the Badger Prairie Healthcare Center in order to receive federal relief funding and to execute related expenditures.

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic there is a need to protect our most vulnerable population by preparing specific areas of the healthcare facility to protect against transmission or provide isolation for those that may be infected.

Specific structural improvements and safety measures are being planned to the BPHCC dental office to make the dental office safe to treat residents and protect staff. Also, an additional isolation area for COVID-19 infected residents is being created for residents to ensure the safety of both residents and staff.

Finally, regular COVID-19 testing for staff and additional personal protective equipment (PPE) and supplies will continue to be required at the facility.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that revenue and expenditure budget authority for the DCDHS – BPHCC Division be increased by \$564,600, and that expenditures are authorized to develop COVID-19 isolation space and further purchase COVID-19 related safety measures at the facility.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the following revenue and expenditure accounts be adjusted in the amounts presented below:
