AUTHORIZING A THREE-PARTY DESIGN ENGINEERING SERVICES CONTRACT BETWEEN  
DANE COUNTY, WISDOT AND CORRE, INC. FOR THE GLACIAL DRUMLIN TRAIL

Dane County has a Project Agreement with the Wisconsin Department of Transportation for \$215,977 through the High Priority Projects (HPP) Program to complete design and engineering for the Glacial Drumlin Trail from the Village of Cottage Grove to Interstate 90.

In February of 2017, Dane County solicited proposals through RFP #116063 for preparation of preliminary design, environmental studies, design study report and final PS&E for the Glacial Drumlin State Trail between the CTH N State parking lot and the eastern right of way of I39 at the existing railroad underpass and recommends awarding a contract for these services to CORRE, Inc. for \$\_\_\_\_\_. Funds are available in the Land & Water Resources 2017 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby authorize a three-party design engineering services contract between Dane County, WisDOT and CORRE, Inc. for design engineering services on the Glacial Drumlin Trail,

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the County Executive is authorized to execute the three-party design contract.
