

ACCEPTANCE OF A NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF CONSERVATION DISTRICTS 2024 TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE GRANT

The Land & Water Resources Department as secured a \$80,000 technical assistance grant from the National Association of Conservation Districts (NACD).

The purpose of the grant is to increase the availability of technical assistance to Land Conservation Division customers for the implementation of soil and water conservation projects funded through the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) – Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP). The funding offsets the costs associated with providing technical assistance by two (2) LTE staff.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the County Board of Supervisors and the Dane County Executive hereby accept the \$80,000 Technical Assistance Grant from NACD.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Land & Water Resources Department Director and County Conservationist are authorized to execute documents necessary to accept the funds, submit reimbursement claims along with necessary supporting documentation.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that revenue account LWRCONSV 80156 "NACD TA GRANT" be increased by \$80,000 and the expense account LWRCONSV 10111 "LTE NACD TA GRANT" be increased by \$73,880 and expense account LWRCONSV 10108 "Social Security" be increased by \$6,120. All funds shall be carried forward until realized and expended.
