AUTHORIZING AN ADDENDUM TO THE AGREEMENT TO HOUSE RELOCATED DANE COUNTY JAIL RESIDENTS AT THE ONEIDA COUNTY JAIL

#### Policy Analysis Statement:

### Brief Description of Proposal -

The Sheriff's Office seeks authorization for an addendum to extend the term of Contract # 15023 from January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024, at a cost of \$653,100, for Oneida County Jail to make available to Dane County Jail residents bed space for a minimum of thirty (30) residents, and a maximum of forty (40) one hundred and ten (110) residents, per day.

#### Current Policy or Practice -

In August 2022, the Sheriff's Office began relocating Dane County jail residents to other county jails due to the closure of the east section of the 7th floor of the City-County Building Jail.

## Impact of Adopting Proposal -

Closure of the east section of the 7th floor of the City-County Building Jail was due to staffing shortages and unsafe and inhumane conditions within the jail. Overcrowding in the jail, including lack of privacy, causes or exacerbates mental health problems, and increase rates of violence, self-harm and suicide. Relocating residents to other county jails is one approach in dealing with an under-resourced jail until a permanent solution is found.
