2014 RES-519 1 AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF MICROSOFT LICENSES 2 3 4 The 2015 Budget includes funding to enter into a new Enterprise Agreement with Microsoft to 5 upgrade and extend the County's Microsoft software licenses. The project will upgrade both the Windows and Office products used by the end user as well as server and database platforms 6 7 used by system administrators. 8 The project is budgeted to cost approximately \$1.4 million (including carryover of 2014 funds) that will cover any upgrades that are needed during a three-year period. At the end of this 9 three-year commitment, the County may decide to purchase another three-year licensing 10 package or to discontinue the agreement. 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that County Executive and County Clerk are 12 authorized to enter into an agreement to purchase Microsoft licensing as authorized in the 2015 13 14 Budget; and 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this project is authorized to proceed in advance of borrowing.
