2014 Aquatic Invasives Control & Prevention-2014 Accomplishments and 2015 Draft Workplan Priorities

Pete Jopke provided an update on the Dane County Land and Water Resources Department Clean Boats Clean Waters program in 2014 and prior years, and notes on 2014 accomplishments, Jopke and Jones asked for LWC input on 2015 program priorities.

2014 Indian Lake Rotenone Treatment Plans PRES-105

Pete Jopke provided an update on the Indian Lake restoration project and answered Commission questions. The rotenone treatment will occur this winter.

Announcements

Power announced that Chief of Staff Wescott is now the Commission's contact in the County Executive's office. Power and others are seeking a meeting with Wescott on continuing efforts to improve communications about water resources programs.

Jones announced receipt of an inquiry from City/County Public Health regarding the Brentwood neighborhood in the City of Madison and neighbors' interest in making a presentation to the Commission about basement flooding. The matter was referred to the water volume work group.

Power said that the Executive Committee and staff continue to identify potential new Commission member candidates to share with the Mayor's office.

Community Engagement Program Progress Report

Jones highlighted accomplishments from the monthly report, and sought input on use of watershed literacy principles developed by the Watershed Network. Updike suggested that the Commission review Community Engagement priorities for 2015 following the retreat. Jones has drafted the position description for the Strategic Engagement Coordinator. Commission members requested to review this draft.

2015 Retreat Planning

Members confirmed the follwing draft 2015 priorities to share at the retreat: chloride, phosphorus, lake levels, and groundwater supply. Members offered suggestions for refining the Executive Committee/Staff suggested retreat organization.
