RECOMMENDATION TO RESTORE ADDITIONAL OPIOID SETTLEMENT FUNDS FOR CREATION OF A CENTRALIZED HARM REDUCTION AND PREVENTION DROP-IN CENTER

Policy Analysis Statement:

Brief Description of Proposal -

This resolution recommends that an additional increment of \$331,200 in Opioid Settlement funding—the amount that was segregated from the initial \$800,000 proposed for the creation of the Harm Reduction and Prevention Drop-In Center (The Center) to meet immediate needs of the PHMDC syringe services program—be restored to the proposed funding for The Center to bring the total funding allocation to \$800,000 for the project and RFP.

Current Policy or Practice -

Currently, the RFP process is in development for creation and implementation of The Center, but the project funding was reduced by \$331,200 from \$800,000 to support PHMDC's needs for expansion of its syringe services program.

Impact of Adopting Proposal -

The intended impact of the recommendation in this resolution is to restore to a total of \$800,000 the amount earmarked from the Opioid Settlement Funds for creation of The Center to ensure its ability to be successful in meeting the County's harm reduction objectives.
