

**SUSPENDING FEES FOR DELINQUENCY SUPERVISION
AND SHELTER HOME PLACEMENT**

Due to Covid-19, many residents of Dane County have experienced sudden loss of income. There have been more than 36,000 new unemployment filings in Dane County, rendering thousands unable to meet their basic, essential needs. The temporary suspension of assessment and collection of these fees will allow Dane County residents to devote their income to meeting their basic needs, and it will further prevent residents from slipping into, or further into, poverty.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors directs the Department of Human Services to suspend the assessment and collection of Delinquency Supervision fees until ninety (90) days after expiration of the County's local state of emergency.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Juvenile Court Program shall also suspend the assessment and collection of Shelter Home service fees until ninety (90) days after expiration of the County's local state of emergency.
