ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT FOR LAKE WAUBESA 2 3 FISH HABITAT FROM THE WI DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES 4 5 The Land & Water Resources Department has secured a \$3,282 Outdoor Recreation Aids grant from the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources (WI DNR). 6 7 8 The purpose of the grant is construct 20 fish stick habitat structures on the north shore of Lake 9 Waubesa as part of the Lower Yahara River Trail construction. In partnership with WI DNR SCR Fisheries, Dane County will place structures in near-shore areas to provide additional 10 course woody debris to support fish, amphibian, herpitiles, macroinvertebrate communities and 11 12 bank protection. These structures will be constructed and placed on the lake during the winter of 2016. The required match for this project is met by in-kind County expenditures of staff and 13 14 equipment use. 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Dane County Board of Supervisors and the 16 Dane County Executive hereby accept the \$3,282 Outdoor Recreation Aids grant from the WI 17 18 DNR. 19 20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the County Executive and County Clerk are authorized to execute documents necessary to accept the funds, 21 22 23 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that expense account LWRCONSV 21503 Matching State Funds and revenue account LWRCONSV 81770 State Aid - Conservation Program be increased by 24 \$3,282. All Funds shall be carried forward until realized and expended. 25 26
