Amending Chapters 2, 32, and 34 of the Dane County Code of Ordinances, Regarding Statutory Offenses

## **Policy Analysis Statement:**

#### Brief Description of Proposal -

The substitute ordinance amendment creates, as a prosecutorial alternative, a \$1 ticket for marijuana in any amount subject to exceptions listed in state statute. This substitute ordinance amendment reduces the proposed forfeiture amount from \$10 to \$1 compared to the original OA.

## Current Policy or Practice -

The original ordinance amendment applies to possession of marijuana in an amount of 25 grams or less and allows for a forfeiture of \$10.

# Impact of Adopting Proposal -

The original ordinance amendment reduced forfeiture revenue by approximately \$10,125. By reducing the forfeiture amount to \$1, the substitute would increase this revenue loss by \$900 to approximately \$11,000. The substitute amendment may increase the opportunity to issue County ordinance violations. However, the number of new ordinance violations is difficult to estimate and would only result in a \$1 increase per offense.
