

46 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Dane County Board of Supervisors
47 supports the language prohibiting the use of No Knock Warrants for preservation of
48 evidence in the passage of the George Floyd Justice in Policing Act.

49
50 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Dane County Board of Supervisors requests the
51 Dane County Sheriff's Office to collect data on the use of no-knock warrants in Dane
52 County and to report that information to the Public Protection and Judiciary Committee
53 on a quarterly basis.

55 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Dane County Board of Supervisors supports the
56 recommendations of the Speaker's Task Force and urges the Wisconsin DOJ to collect
57 data on the use of no-knock warrants in Wisconsin.

59 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that a copy of this resolution be sent to Governor Evers,
60 the Dane County state legislative delegation and congressional delegation, and Dane
61 County Sheriff Barrett.
