We are Rob and Jennifer Anderson, and we reside at 4307 Oak Lane Road, Brooklyn, WI.

As a long time resident in the Town of Rutland, recent years have become “not very country like” due to the following reasons. It always HAS and WILL be deeply important to us that our community remains peaceful and safe.

My reasons for the opposition to CUP 02582:

1. Owner/Operator Kevin Hahn stood before The Town of Rutland Board and many concerned citizens and blatantly and clearly stated, I quote “I am a your good neighbor in this township.
